



# Set of 50 Phonics Games



These interactive phonics games are a fun way to master word decoding and fluency skills. They also provide an opportunity for you to enrich your students' vocabulary, and to explain the meaning of new words to expand their comprehension. Each game offers a different twist as it focuses on words with the sound being taught. For many, the game is what students look forward to when the lesson begins. "Do we get to play a game today?" they ask. In this way, they're eager to participate in the necessary practice in preparation for reading the *Go Phonics* story for that lesson. (The games tie in to the stories.) The games can be played one-on-one, in small groups, on game days, or as an after school activity. There are now 12 plastic boards, 3 spinners, and over 1400 cards that when assembled, store neatly in 2 trays.

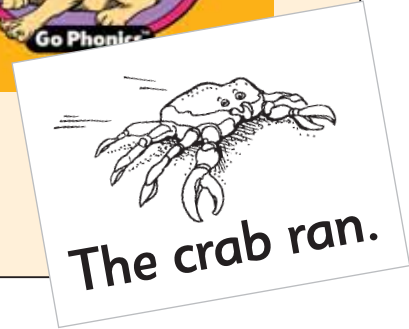
### EXAMPLES:

**Big Foot card game** oo = /oo/ The cards in this game all have a foot on the back. They are the feet of a chicken, dog, duck, person, etc. The object is to get as many matching pairs as you can. Cards are placed face up on the table (words showing). A student draws a card, reads it (*shook, hook, or crook...*), then places it in front of her so the foot shows. The card with **Big Foot** is a wild card. It is saved until the end and used to make a pair with any unmatched foot but the sneaker. The player with the most pairs is the winner. This decoding practice is preparation for reading the story *Cooking on the Front Burner*.



### Fat Cat card game

Large cards for short vowel games give students an opportunity to practice reading phrases and sentences with short **a** words, and gain extra points for words that rhyme, form a sentence, show ownership, are homographs (same words, different meanings: *bat, bat*)...





Sylvia Davison, *Go Phonics* author, plays the *Stuck Truck* game with a student to give her practice decoding words with ck. She sweeps a finger across the word on the card to encourage smoother blending of the sounds.
